


Dear Parent / Guardian,

Classes are open to students who have **completed** grades kindergarten through eighth. Camp will begin **Tuesday, June 3, 2014** and end **Thursday, June 26, 2014** at **Lake Charles Boston Academy, 1509 Enterprise Boulevard** in Lake Charles. The purpose of Summer Arts Camp is to provide children with a variety of creative art experiences on an individual basis within an open-studio environment.
